THE POLO CLUB DU DOMAINE DE CHANTILLY IS ORGANIZING POLO COURSES FOR YOUNG PLAYERS FROM JULY 1ST TO JULY 7TH 2024.

At "La Ferme de Apremont" (17th century) an exceptional site on the edge of the forest of Chantilly, the princely capital of horses. All meals are organized at its Clubhouse .

Living accommodations will be provided for with select host families of the Polo Club.

The participants will play in a two-day tournament to be held at the end of the course on July 8th and 9th.

The Club is ideally located near Charles de Gaule airport, 15 minutes from Parc Astérix and 50 minutes from Euro Disney.

The illustrious grounds will offer the great opportunity to improve your skills with top-notch horses.

The Polo School offers young European players fundamental learning of all aspects of polo: from insight of the horse, to practicing the sport, to the care and work of the horses.

THIS PROGRAM IS TAILORED TO YOUNG RIDERS UNDER 18-YEARS OLD.

OBJECTIVES OF THE COURSE

 - > Behavior of the horse
 - > Dressage in free rein
 - > Preparation of the horses: bands saddle bridle girth
 - > Care of the horses:
 - * Stables
 - * Farrier
- Polo riding
 - > Position on horseback
 - > Aids and gaits on horseback

- STICK AND BALL
 - > Relaxation of the horse and muscular strengthening
 - > Work with the mallet on horseback
- PRACTICE
 - > Knowledge of the rules of the game of polo
 - > Roda Polo®
 - > Training sessions with practices
 - > Participation in a tournament
